Freshman / Coach: Ben Heuberger | Parents: Ryan & Rori

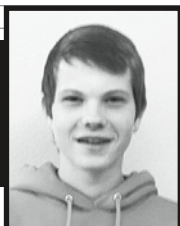

Senior / Coach: Vic Downs | Parents: Chuck & Sharon

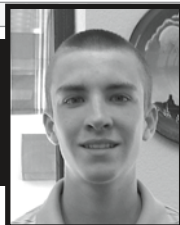
