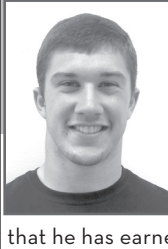


TAYLOR FORD

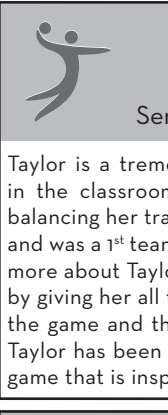


TANNER SCANLON

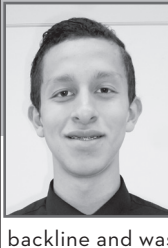


TAYLOR PETERSEN

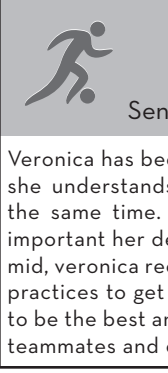


JOSE BAUTISTA
