Re: City Notice to Promoter for Dragging the Gut Festival 2018

You are receiving this notice because you have been identified as a Sponsor or Community Partner for the Dragging the Gut Festival promoted by Reuben Contreras, Jr. Enclosed, please find a copy of a letter placing Mr. Contreras on notice that he has failed to seek the required permits for his festival and he is in violation of the conditions placed on his 2017 festival permit requiring reimbursement for the costs incurred by the City to provide enhanced public safety staffing for the festival.

As a result of Mr. Contreras' failure or refusal to comply with the City's permitting requirements, his ability to lawfully conduct many of the festival activities is now in jeopardy. With the festival advertised to begin in less than 60 days, and no application yet submitted for review, the City cannot provide any assurance that the required Special Event Permit and/or Street Use Permit will be issued in time for many of the activities associated with the event to occur.

Re: The Dragging the Gut Festival 2018

Dear. Mr. Contreras:

The City of McMinnville has been made aware that you are actively soliciting sponsors, vendors and participants for the above referenced festival event that is advertised to be held on August 24-25, 2018, at various venues within the City of McMinnville, Oregon. As the City has informed you repeatedly over the past several years, a permit from the City is required for many of the proposed activities related to your festival event. However, despite the fact that we are now less than 60 days from the advertised start of your event, you have failed or refused to apply for the required permits.

As you know, a Special Event Permit and a Street Use Permit are required by the City for certain types of events on public and/or private property in order to ensure that adequate planning has occurred and that appropriate resources are in place to protect the health, welfare and safety of the public. In addition, as you are also aware, the City has not yet received your reimbursement payment for the costs incurred by the City to provide enhanced public safety staffing in support of last year's event.

Please be advised that your ability to lawfully conduct many of the festival activities is now in jeopardy, as a result of your failure to apply for permits for the 2018 festival as well as your failure to pay when due the amounts owing to the City for the 2017 festival. In addition, without receiving a complete application for your proposed event, the City cannot provide any assurance that the necessary permits can be issued in time for any or all of the activities associated with your event to occur. You are strongly encouraged to contact the McMinnville Fire Department regarding your intentions concerning the application for a Special Event Permit and/or a Street Use Permit for Dragging the Gut Festival 2018.

If you should attempt to hold any portion of your festival event without the required permits, the City will take action to stop your event from occurring. If the City is forced to take this action, many persons beyond yourself may be negatively impacted, including sponsors, vendors, participants and other

members of the public. Therefore, the City is requesting that you act responsibly by initiating the required permitting processes without further delay.

In order to mitigate damages that might be caused by the cancellation of all or a portion of your event, the City is sending a copy of this notice to the individuals and businesses that you have identified as festival sponsors and community partners on your festival website, as indicated below, and will be taking additional steps to inform the public that permits have neither been sought nor issued for your event. We look forward to hearing from you regarding your plans for complying with the City's permitting requirements for this year's event.
