

Please respond to the following questions and provide any documentation to support your response by August 13, 2014. You may call me at 503-986-1518 if you have any questions about the content of this letter.

1. Who provided the printing and mailing for the two pieces of campaign literature?
2. Did you place the order for each piece? If you did not place the orders, who did on your behalf? Please provide contact information for that person.
3. Who was your contact person with the business that provided the two pieces of campaign literature?
4. Did ORTL design both pieces of the campaign literature? If no, who provided the design services for each? Please provide contact information for that person.
5. On what date was the order placed for each of the pieces of campaign literature?
6. Did you or any agent of ORTL have any communication with any agent of the Nearman campaign regarding either piece of the campaign literature? If yes, provide the name and contact information of the agent(s) involved.
7. Were the expenses incurred for each piece of the campaign literature reported in ORESTAR? If yes, please provide the transaction id numbers associated with the payments, as well as identifying which expense is associated with which mail piece (A or B).

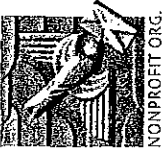

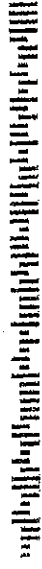

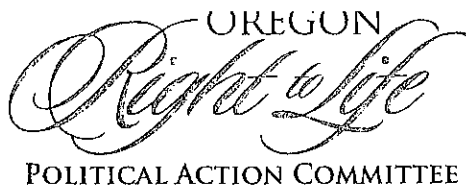

Why we've withdrawn our endorsement of Representative Jim Thompson

Dea

It's a rare occasion that Oregon Right to Life PAC withdraws its endorsement from a previously endorsed candidate. And only under the most troubling circumstances. So with much deliberation and sadness of heart I write to inform you that Oregon Right to Life PAC is no longer endorsing your state representative, Jim Thompson.

I have been working in politics and with pro-life candidates for almost 20 years now. Through the years I have been proud of the great many pro-life legislators who have stood strong and unmovable throughout their career with the same high principles they had when elected.

I have also seen a few who have become too comfortable in office. They allow politics to replace principle; and allow the prestige of the office to conflict with commitments made to constituents. I have observed this happen to Representative Thompson and am concerned about him returning to office.

Representative Thompson has flip-flopped on issues in the past that are of no concern to Oregon Right to Life, however, continuous flip-flopping reveals an unhealthy character trait.

This last winter, Representative Thompson did a dramatic flip-flop on an issue with deep moral implications. Thompson has always claimed to stand solidly for traditional marriage, but in a major reversal, he signed on with "Republicans for same sex marriage." Oregon Right to Life PAC does not take a stand on this issue, but we're troubled by this dramatic 360 turn. Furthermore, with this turn he made a completely "new set of friends", all of whom are pro-abortion.

His most infamous new friend is former U.S. Senator Bob Packwood. Senator Packwood's main interest is, and always has been, promoting abortion. He has even said his greatest memory is his part in defending abortion rights. Senator Packwood has given money to Thompson's re-election campaign.

We no longer trust Jim Thompson. And we do not think you can either.

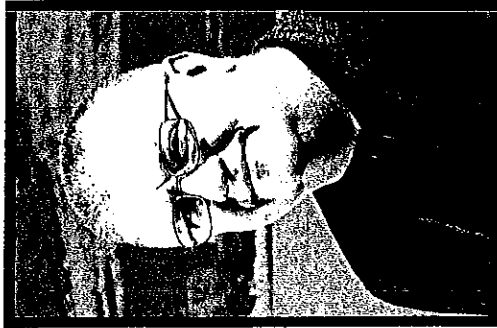

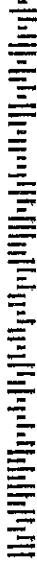
