WINE CLASSIC CANCELED AS STATE BANS LARGE EVENTS

All gatherings of more than 250 people canceled for four weeks; other guidelines issued

SALEM — Oregon should prepare for thousands of cases of coronavirus, Gov. Kate Brown said Thursday as she announced a ban on all gatherings of more than 250 people statewide for four weeks to try to stop the spread.

Appearing at a news conference, the governor said she and other state officials are also worried about testing capacity, which a health official estimated was about 80 per day, and said "the federal convergent is the only

HAVE YOU CHECKED YOUR EXHAUST SYSTEM LATELY?

Today's cars have very good exhaust systems. In fact, the exhaust system now plays a more important role on vehicles than it did in the past. Indeed, it's job is not only to get rid of the gases produced by the engine's internal combustion, it must also clean them up almost completely in order to meet environmental standards. But, just as with any other car part, the exhaust system will have the unfortunate tendency to deteriorate with time, its worst enemies being heat and corrosion.

A quick glance at the system might not reveal any flaws, but a closer inspection could turn out to be more informative.

In the case of heat, if you don't drive long enough to heat up the metal and allow it to dry out completely, condensation will build up within the exhaust system, allowing rust — the system's second worst enemy — to develop.

Although many recent exhaust systems are made of stainless steel, rust will still develop, mainly on the exterior. The exhaust system is composed of several parts, beginning with the exhaust manifold which connects from the engine, the catalytic converter (an expensive part to replace!) the muffler and/or resonator and the pipes themselves, clamps, brackets, hangers and heat shields. Finally, modern cars and trucks also have sensors in the exhaust system which work with the computer.


Exhaust systems on modern cars and trucks last much longer than they used to on older vehicles, however there may still be some flaws that could not only lead to a system failure, but could also pose health concerns.

Have your exhaust system inspected, especially if your

welding points could be weaker and rust, thus causing a slight leak that could possibly become hazardous over time. Have the system inspected by an expert — don't wait until it becomes noisy.

At the same time, have the rubber straps closely inspected. If they break, the whole system will dangle and will eventually break. If you hear a rattling noise under the vehicle, chances are one of the heat shields over the exhaust system is loose. Don't remove it, have it repaired; all of the shields are important! •




