### PUZZLES & COMICS

The newspaper is more than just words, pictures and information. Each issue features a selection of mental exercises to keep the brain sharp and comics to provide a quick hit of amusement.

The News-Register publishes three crosswords each week -- King Crossword, Super Crossword and the popular, sometimes edgy Quigley crossword -- along with other puzzles for readers to improve their memory and hone their problem solving skills.
