The birth of the Les Schwab Tire Company took place in January of 1952 when Les Schwab purchased a small OK Rubber Welders tire store in Prineville, Oregon. With a \$3,500 investment and a strong desire to own his own business, Les increased the sales of this store from \$32,000 to \$150,000 in the first year. Les had a powerful determination to provide opportunity for people who could not afford to go into business for themselves.

On January 1, 1954 Les started the first profit share program with his Redmond, Oregon store manager and this was just the start of things to come. In 1955, Les opened his third OK Rubber Welders tire store in Bend and, within a year, changed the name to Les Schwab Tire Center.

This was an important time for the Les Schwab Tire Company. As the company continued to grow, Les developed what is known as the supermarket tire store concept. He had a goal to have his warehouse in his showroom, so customers could walk through the racks of tires and pick out the ones they wanted for their vehicles. Along with this concept, Les decided to stock more than one brand of tire in each size to give his customers a choice. This stocking policy was not popular with the maior rubber companies at the time, but was an important part of Les' supermarket tire store concept.

In 1966, the Les Schwab Tire

Company became totally independent following Les' decision to take down all OK Rubber Welders signs and replace them with the Les Schwab sign. This was a big year, as Les formed the Les Schwab Retirement Trust for his employees and purchased six stores and a retread shop in Idaho, bringing the total company store count to 18.

The company continued to grow, and by 1972 had a total of 35 stores. Retreading continued to play a big part with the company and this is the year Les Schwab's More-Mile retreading process was developed for truck tire customers. More-Mile retreading continues to play an important role in Les Schwab's truck retread business.

Today the Les Schwab Tire Company has more than 500 locations with plans to open roughly 10 to 15 new stores a year. As one of the largest independent tire companies in the United States, Les Schwab continues to expand in Colorado, Central California and California's Inland Empire.

In addition to operating one of the largest tire retreading plants in the country, Les Schwab has a distribution center with more than two million square feet under one roof in Prineville, Oregon. The company is proud to stock more than five million tires at all times, company-wide, for its customers.

The success of the Les Schwab Tire Company has been made possible by its wonderful customers, who are the

most important people in the company's business. Nothing happens in the company until a customer decides to buy a tire, wheel, alignment or any of the other services offered. CANCER PATIENTS NEED MORE THAN MEDICAL CARE

That's where the community-based Willamette Valley Cancer Foundation steps in

The community-based nonprofit Willamette Valley Cancer Foundation manages a Patient Financial Assistance program for cancer patients in Lincoln, Tillamook and Yamhill counties.

The Cancer Foundation provides direct assistance with household expenses like gas, groceries, insurance, prescriptions, transportation, utilities and more.

"Taking away some of the financial burden often brought on by a cancer diagnosis and treatment plan allows patients to concentrate on their health and healing," says Patty Williams, executive director

To qualify for assistance, applicants must reside in one of the three counties, have a current cancer diagnosis, be undergoing cancer treatment or within six months of treatment and demonstrate financial need.

Williams, who joined the cancer foundation in 2020, works with administrative assistant Lisa Boschee, who does the day-to-day work helping patients/clients with bills and other needs.

Cancer affects more than just the patients. "Entire families can be financially and emotionally sidelined by a cancer diagnosis," Williams said. That makes the cancer foundation's mission so important: "So No One Fights Alone."

Established in 2002, WVCF enjoys a close relationship with Willamette Valley Medical Center and Oregon Oncology Specialists. All three are located at the H.R. Hoover, MD, Cancer Center. The space allows staff direct access to patients and resources to keep operating costs low. The Cancer Foundation also maintains a presence on the coast with monthly appointments at Dr. Bob Health Centre in Lincoln City.

You Can Get Local Help With A Social Security Disability Claim

Dealing with the Social Security Administration for a Disability claim can be very frustrating and complicated, especially if you are denied and have to appeal all the way to a Hearing. Luckily McMinnville has a local attorney who can help.

If you now have impairments that make you unable to work, you might be able to get Social Security Disability benefits. If you have taken early retirement benefits because you can no longer work, you might be able to file for Disability and no longer have an early retirement penalty. However, the Social Security system is complex and winning a claim can be hard. It's not just telling a judge you can't do things anymore. Opinions must be obtained from doctors, records properly obtained, vocational analysis performed, along with other complex tasks.



Abbey Road harvested its first wine grape crop in 2021. A couple of wines from that vintage are among those in flights served at the tasting room. "We are looking to a full harvest this year," the Wilkens said. The couple, who live in Lake Oswego, also are co-owners of a lauded Portland restaurant, Quaintrelle. "Our goal is to be able to provide all of our needed produce for

the restaurant entirely from the farm," they said. The garden also contributes to the multi-course breakfasts for B&B guests prepared by innkeeper and chef Will Preisch. The farm also is adding more animals each year. Its event center is busy with activities such as retirement dinners, weddings, holiday bazaars and other private parties. "We are wrapping up a pretty busy event season," the Wilkens said, adding that they are looking forward to the next round of events. Abbey Road Farm is located at 10200 N.E Oak Springs Farm Road, east of Carlton and north of Lafayette. The tasting room is now open from 11 a.m. to 5 p.m. seven days a week. 



GRAND RONDE TRIBE LOOKS BEYOND ITS PAST TO SECURE ITS FUTURE

Serving members, celebrating sovereignty and preserving traditions

The story of the Confederated Tribes of Grand Ronde is one of persistence and perseverance. A western Oregon Treaty Tribe, Grand Ronde includes more than 30 tribes and bands that resided throughout western Oregon, southwestern Washington and northern California. They lived off the land where fish and game were plentiful.

Tribal members were removed from these homelands and relocated to the Grand Ronde valley after signing treaties with the United States Government in 1855. The original 60,000-acre Grand Ronde Reservation was formally established in 1857, but federal policies chipped away these lands. Tribal lands were eventually reduced to a single cemetery by the time Grand Ronde was terminated in 1954.

Grand Ronde community members refused to accept termination as its fate. After years of hard work and dedication, the Grand Ronde Tribe was

restored in 1983 and took possession of its 10,000-acre reservation in 1988. The opening of Spirit Mountain Casino in 1995 provided financial stability to the Tribe while being one of the largest employers in Polk and Yamhill counties. Its success has allowed the Tribe to rebuild its land base and provide opportunities and services to the community and its members.

The Grand Ronde Tribe is a community known as a caring people dedicated to the principles of honesty and integrity. Since restoration, Grand Ronde has continued to rebuild its nation, strengthen its culture, and develop programs to meet the needs of its members. Grand Ronde strives to preserve tribal sovereignty, its tribal culture and its cultural traditions for future generations.

Like areas across the United States, the county faces a growing crisis of substance abuse, she said. "The need was bigger than the current solutions, so a better solution became my goal," she said.

Reynolds said she has deep affection for Yamhill County, "with its unique blend of natural beauty, community spirit and untapped potential."

Reynolds, like most Provoking Hope's employees, has struggled herself. "We know that change is possible because we have seen it firsthand," she said.

She said she has found purpose in helping others overcome their problems.

In addition, team members also hold various specialized certifications, including Traditional Health Worker (THW), Peer Support Specialist (PSS), yearly Trauma-Informed Certification (TIF), and certification in supervision, being a youth specialist, pharmaceutical and first aid.

CRMs also must pass a child welfare background check, and have at least two

Our job is to tap that potential, serve it, and continually reassess it. That served potential can give purpose. Since the doors opened, Marjorie House has offered a Life Enrichment program for all its residents. That means staff are there seven days a week, more than eight hours a day, to "engage people in a productive way." The community Life Enrichment staff develops monthly activity plans filled with five to seven group options residents can enjoy each day. While most activities are done in groups, one-on-one engagement between a resident and a staff member can be equally enriching, and is sometimes the most appropriate way to create a resident's sense of peace and purpose.

The nature of dementia is for the body and brain activity to decrease, often making people reclusive. But keeping


the mind and body active and engaged has plenty of positive benefits, such as helping to spark memories and increase people's physical ability. And elevated physical ability can lessen the risks, for instance, of a life-ending or debilitating fall, which is a critical concern in longterm care

Today the farm is home to about 60 female and male alpacas of nearly every color and age.

"We started with Wings and a prayer that things would work out well," the Colemans said. "It has worked very well and we've never looked back."

Randy guit his "paycheck" job as a journeyman mechanic in 2003 to operate Wings and A Prayer Alpacas fulltime. Barbara's job as an executive secretary ended two months later, and both have been fulltime alpaca farmers ever since. "These animals are our passion AND



Domaine Willamette offers tastings, tours of biodynamicallyfarmed vineyards overlooking the Dundee Hills

Domaine Willamette produces worldclass méthode traditionnelle sparkling wines, aged in an underground cellar at the biodynamically-farmed Bernau Estate Vineyard in the Dundee Hills.

The winery and tasting room opened in 2022 just off Highway 99W between Davton and Dundee.

Guests can taste the winery's sparkling wines, made using the traditions of the Champagne region of France, alongside Pinot Noirs from the Willamette Valley's Dundee Hills AVA and bold reds made from grapes grown on the Oregon side of the Walla Walla Valley.

Tours of the biodynamic gardens and vineyards are available, as are food pairings with the wine. Private events are a specialty, as well.

Domaine Willamette belongs to the Dundee Hills Winegrowers Association and the Willamette Valley Wineries Association.

The winery won a 2023 Landmark Award from the Portland Business Journal, which recognized the winery's incorporation of art pieces by Xander Griffith and Kathy Kun, among others. The award also honored its mass timber roof, solar shingles, waterfall and other

elements that evoke the landscape of Oregon wine.

Surrounding the tasting room is the Bernau Estate Vineyard, which is farmed using biodynamic practices and is certified biodynamic by Demeter.

The site's original 15 acres of Pinot Noir were planted in 1994; in 2019, the vineyard crew added nine acres of Pinot Meunier, Chardonnay and more Pinot Noir.

Jim and Jan Bernau founded Domaine Willamette in 2017, and the groundbreaking was celebrated by fellow wine enthusiast shareholders (Jim founded Willamette Valley Vineyards in 1983). Jan Bernau oversaw the collaboration between Boxwood architects, landscape designer Steven Koch, general contractor CD Redding, subcontractors, local artists and Willamette team members to create the tasting room, biodynamic gardens and underground cellar.

The cellar is key: wines are aged for at least 18 months on their lees before bottling. The hands-on approach also includes disgorgement to remove sediment, contributing to the wine's delicate bubbles, rich aromas and refined taste.

World-class hand-crafted Pinot Noir since 1983

Willamette Valley Vineyards is a story about a native Oregonian with a bold idea. Iim Bernau was introduced to wine by the first emigrating winemaker since Prohibition, Richard Sommer, who believed it was in Oregon — not California — where he could grow worldclass Pinot Noir. Looking for a lawyer to obtain licenses the state hadn't issued in over 30 years, Richard drove to Roseburg, where he hired Jim's dad.

In 1981, Jim began a search for vineyard land, finding an overgrown pioneer plum orchard in the Salem Hills. Two years later, he planted Pinot Noir, watering his vines with a patchwork of garden hoses.


While the vines grew, Jim helped Oregon winegrowers enact legislation making wineries a permitted use on farmland, establishing the Oregon Wine Board, allowing direct shipment of wine

and authorizing wine tastings in stores and restaurants.


Today, Jim has received much recognition for his work. Named "One of America's Great Pinot Noir Producers" by Wine Enthusiast Magazine, Willamette Valley Vineyards sustainably farms more than 500 acres of vineyards to produce small lots of estate-grown Pinot Noir.
