McMinnville care centers could make 107 unnecessary emergency calls for the amount of money the Oregon Health Care Association has spent in an attempt to ensure the centers never have to pay a dirne.

Association leaders are spending approximately \$160,000 in McMinnville to overturn Ordinance 5059, which imposes care centers with a \$1,500 fine for every 911 call deemed unnecessary.

The law, passed Oct. 9 last year, also requires care center administrators to obtain specialty business licenses. Licenses cost \$500 for an initial application fee. Renewing the license costs \$200 annually for every bed in the care center.

Mayor Scott Hill said only a few hundred dollars — at most — have been spent against the charter amendment before voters on the Nov. 5 ballot. By law, campaign contributions cannot be made using city money, but councilors can contribute personally.

McMinnville taxpayers are also spending money on the election.

Yamhill County Clerk Brian Van Bergen estimated it will cost local taxpayers between \$60,000 and \$80,000 to decide the fate of the charter amendment and the law it seeks to overturn.

Terms & Conditions

Credit and charge privileges will be established through application and approval.

Local rates are non-commissionable. Agreement rates are based on conditions noted in the signed advertising agreement.

Advertising cancelled after it has been type set will be charged at a rate of \$2.00 per column inch.

Advertising space, including preprinted inserts will not be sold to anyone for the purpose of resale.

Payments in full are due within 15 days of the billing date indicated on the statement. Amounts unpaid by the end of the following billing cycle have a 1.5% late fee added per month (18% APR). Accounts with balances 30 days or more past due may have credit discontinued.
