





What We Provide

As the only provider of domestic and sexual violence support and emergency services in Yamhill County, Henderson House provides safety, shelter and services which empower adult and child survivors as they move from being victims of domestic violence, sexual assault/abuse, stalking or human trafficking to becoming survivors. We work to promote change in the societal conditions that allow oppression and all forms of violence by providing direct services, education and outreach.

Within the confidential emergency shelter, our Henderson House advocates assist clients and families by providing options for a more long-term stable environment, information, referrals and aids and supports client goals to build positive relationships beyond their time with Henderson House.

In 2023, Henderson House provided 2,520 shelter nights for survivors and their children. We answered 1,190 calls for support. Clients were served over the phone and in person with 566 safety plans. We provided 10 Community presentations. We offer a variety of services such as emergency shelter for survivors of Domestic and Sexual Violence. We assist with filling out and filing of Restraining Orders, along with court accompaniment. Henderson House is focused on providing the best services possible to continue our efforts in supporting victims, survivors and families towards a violence-free life.

The State of Community Newspapers

Oregon has seen a 40 percent reduction in community newspapers in the statewide association, leaving many Oregon cities in a news desert – a town with no newspaper, or being served by a ghost newspaper – published from a larger community, usually devoid of local news.

The OPIP Story

Oregon Public Information Partnership, re-birthed from Oregon Public Affairs Network, is using its 501(c)(3) status to assist Oregon independent community newspapers in developing an additional channel of revenue through donations to specific journalistic projects.

Solutions

One solution we champion is newspaper sustainability legislation on either the state or federal level, giving qualified community newspapers refundable tax credits tied to news staff salaries. OPIP provides a vehicle for people to make tax deductible contributions to **OPIP approved journalistic projects** by our partner newspapers.
