Beyond Backpacks is an annual event that was established in 2004. The organization helps children in Yamhill County from high needs families in grades K-12 receive new backpacks, "chalked" full of school supplies.

Children who attend the event get to pick out their own brand new backpack and receive school supplies appropriate to their grade level. 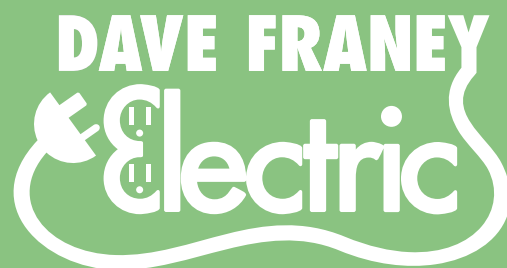

Providing culturally aware outreach, education and services for victims of domestic and sexual violence through leadership, hope and respect for thriving families.

What We Provide

As the only provider of domestic and sexual violence support and emergency services in Yamhill County, Henderson House provides safety, shelter and services which empower adult and child survivors as they move from being victims of domestic violence, sexual assault/abuse, stalking or human trafficking to becoming survivors. We work to promote change in the societal conditions that allow oppression and all forms of violence by providing direct services, education and outreach.

Within the confidential emergency shelter, our Henderson House advocates assist clients and families by providing options for a more long-term stable environment, information, referrals and aids and supports client goals to build positive relationships beyond their time with Henderson House.

Henderson House currently offers weekly domestic violence and sexual assault support groups in English and Spanish. In early 2020 our Youth Advocate will facilitate Girls Circle, an evidence-based gender-response group for girls and helps them to make healthy choices and build confidence.

In 2018, Henderson House provided 1868 shelter nights for survivors and their children. Our support groups were attended 797 times and provided community awareness to 1013 people through community engagement presentations. We answered 1219 crisis calls and made over 1352 safety plans with individuals. Henderson House is focused on providing the best services possible to continue our efforts in supporting victims, survivors and families toward a violence-free life.

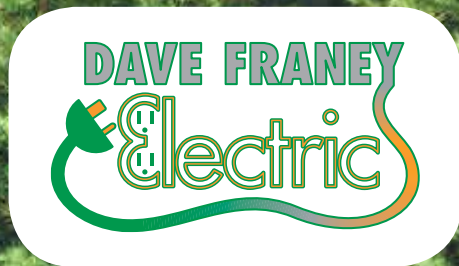
