Give Hope for the Holidays.

On average, 150 abused and neglected children come under the jurisdiction of the court in Yamhill County every year. With a Court Appointed Special Advocate (CASA) dedicated to their case, these children have a reliable positive presence throughout their child welfare journey.

Over the past three decades, Yamhill County CASA has served an average of 70% of these children. While our rates are among the highest in the state, and Oregon CASA programs' rates are among the highest in the nation, we have an obligation to do better.

Over the last year, we have recruited, screened, and trained 21 new CASA volunteers. Our comprehensive support has also led to a volunteer retention rate increase of more than 10%. As a result, 80% of children in need had CASA volunteers advocating for their best interests in 2023.

YAMHILL COUNTY CASA PROGRAM: a powerful voice for children.

Who are CASA Volunteers?

- Court Appointed Special Advocate volunteers are members of the communitylike you!
- In cases of child abuse or neglect, CASA volunteers are the Judge's eyes and ears outside of court, and the child's voice in the courtroom
- They work independent of, but in collaboration with, the Department of Human Services and attorneys, ensuring that the needs of the child are not overlooked in the complex system of child welfare

What do CASA Volunteers do?

- CASA volunteers routinely meet with the child, their family, and all adults that help shape the child's world
- From their observations, the CASA volunteer makes recommendations to the judge about what is in the best interest of the child

Why is this work so important?

- We believe that every child deserves a safe and stable home
- We know that children on this path have better outcomes when they have a consistent and caring adult to walk alongside them every step of the way and advocate on their behalf
- We support family preservation and understand that it is in the best interests for children to rejoin their family as soon as safely possible, whenever possible

We recruit, screen, train, and support volunteers who:

- understand the value of family history and connections
- are culturally mindful and are sensitive to barriers that trauma experiences introduce
- are committed to our mission to advocate for the best interests of abused and neglected children under the jurisdiction of the court
- become knowledgeable about the array of services available to help families reunite stronger & safer

To help parents get off to a strong start, we work with expecting families, or who have a newborn under 3 months. We then continue services for the first 3 years of the child's life. In-home family support is offered weekly in the beginning, then varies in frequency as services continue.

RELIEF NURSERIES

Families with children ages 0-5 receive in-home family support focused on their needs and at the frequency that works for them. Therapeutic classrooms are designed to meet the social-emotional needs of toddlers and preschoolers and run 2 days per week from 9am -12pm.

PARENT EDUCATION



We focus on supporting those who care for kids 0 to 17 years old by enhancing their caregiving skills and practices through group education. Our group series run from 6-8 weeks both in-person and online. When in person we provide childcare and food.
